Figure 1: The Resource-Consumption-Hierarchy

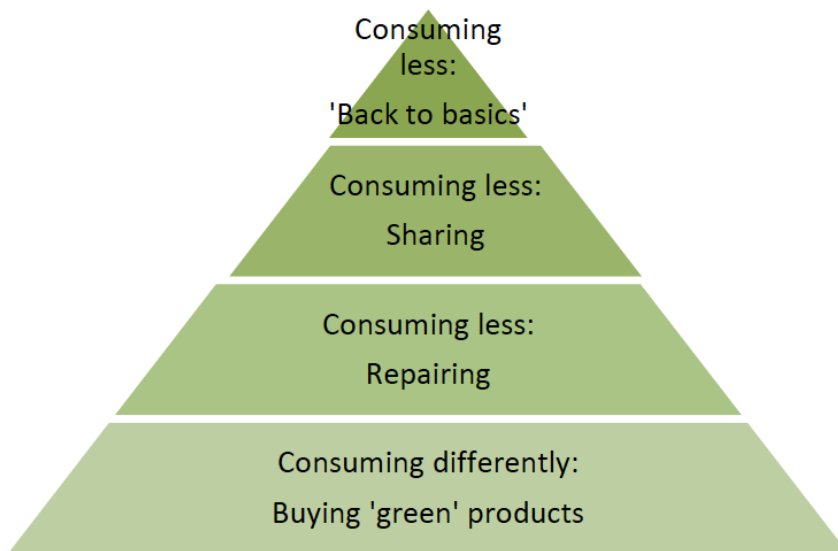
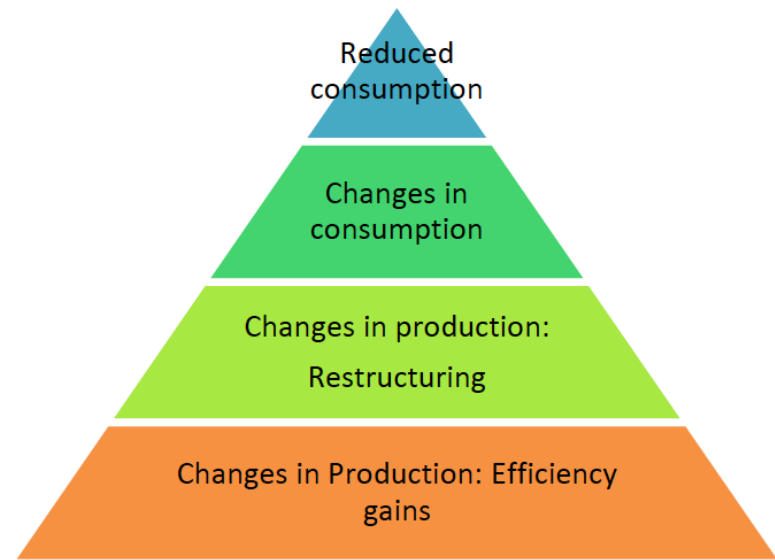


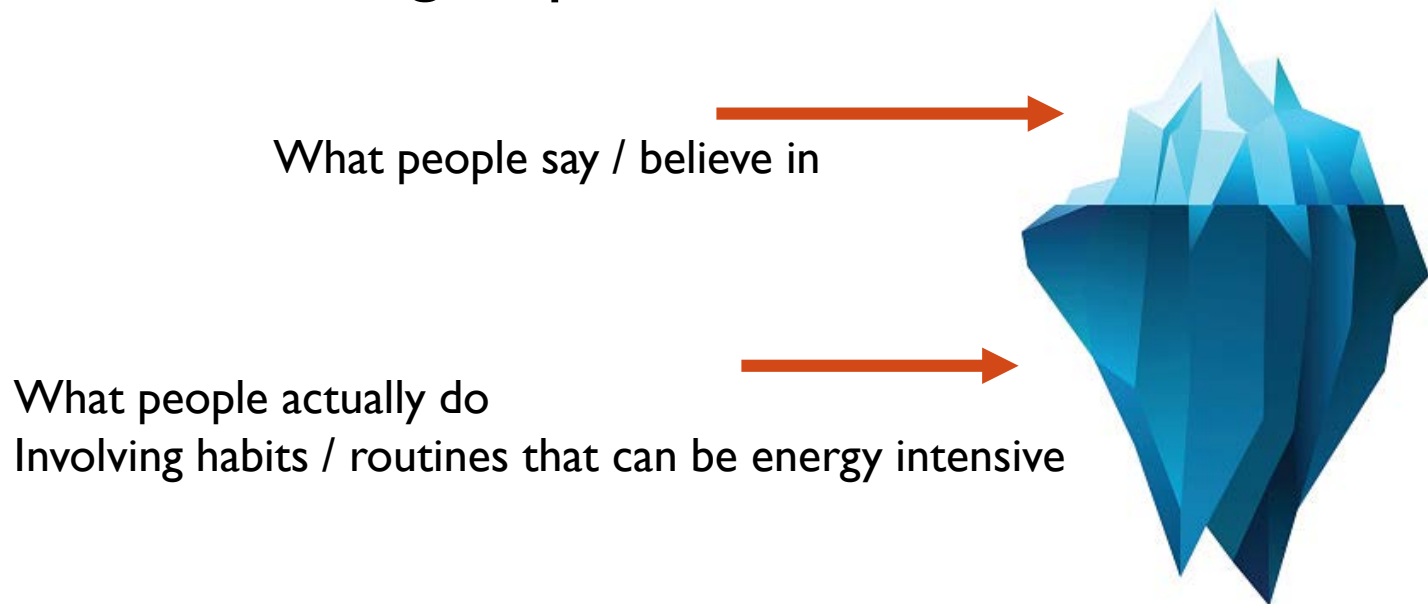
Figure 2: The SCP Policy Priorities Pyramid
